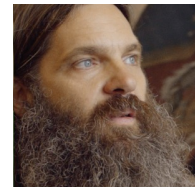
Love in the Time of Fentanyl

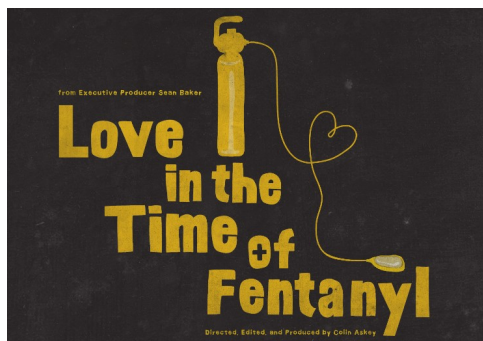
